Information for Carlinville Invitational

Schools: Carlinville, Calhoun, Greenfield, Greenville, Moweaqua Central A&M, Springfield Lanphier, Carlyle, and Valmeyer

Schedule: Included in this document.

Tiebreakers: The number of matches won in pool play will determine the standings after pool play is completed. If there is a tie in matches won after pool play, the tiebreakers will go in the following way:

1. Head to head competition
2. Winning percentage in games.
3. Scoring differential using all games played.
4. Coin flip

Medical supplies, etc.: Carlinville does not employ an athletic trainer. Schools should bring their own basic medical supplies, tape their own players' ankles, provide and apply their own band-aids, etc. Of course, we are willing to help when we are able (e.g., providing ice).

Locker Rooms: Locker rooms will be assigned for each team upon request. They will be shared, so please protect your valuables.

Bus Parking: Buses should park in the high school parking lot (located on the west side of our building)

Trophies/Awards: Plaques will be awarded to the 1st and 2nd place teams. An all-tournament team will be announced at the conclusion of the championship match. All-tournament team voting information will be provided upon your arrival.

Warm-ups: a full warm-up will be used for the first 2 matches in each gym; thereafter, an abbreviated warm-up (3-3-1) will be used. Carlinville will provide warm-up balls.

Concessions: Last year's featured items included Bagels-Muffins-Fruit-Pulled Pork BBQ Sandwiches-Pulled Pork Nachos-Loaded Nachos-Walking Tacos-Loaded Baked Potatoes. This year will likely be similar!

Admission: \$4 for adults and \$2 for students and senior citizens.
